

ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES SUPERVISOR – Novato Sanitary District, Novato, CA. Salary \$7,673 - \$9,326/mo; CalPERS 2% at 60; no Social Security deductions.

The **Environmental Services Supervisor** is the supervisory level class responsible for the overall operation of District's laboratory and environmental services related functions, including process control, industrial wastewater, pretreatment, pollution prevention, WDR and NPDES monitoring programs, and regulatory compliance. Under general direction, supervises, directs and coordinates the activities and operations of the District's laboratory and environmental services related functions, including non-domestic waste monitoring and inspection, and generally pollution prevention and pretreatment; ensures and has overall accountability for compliance with federal, state and local laws, codes and regulations; ensures safe work practices and service quality; serves as a technical resource for assigned staff; performs other related duties as required. Functions as project manager for work performed by outside, contract, and commercial laboratories.

Education and/or Experience:

Any combination of education and experience that has provided the knowledge, skills and abilities necessary for an Environmental Services Supervisor, with a minimum of seven years of equivalent experience in wastewater and water laboratory testing, analysis and control, including a minimum of two years of lead or supervisory experience, and a bachelor's degree in chemistry, biochemistry, biology, sanitary engineering, public health engineering or a directly related field.

Licenses/Certificates:

Possession of a valid California motor vehicle driver's license and a good driving record consistent with requirements established by the District. Failure to maintain an acceptable driving record shall be cause for discipline, up to and including dismissal; possession of a Laboratory Analyst Grade IV (or obtain within one year of hire) and Environmental Compliance Certificate Grade III (or obtain within one year of hire) from the California Water Environment Association (CWEA). Note that probationary requirements shall not be considered to be completed until CWEA Laboratory Grade IV and ECA Grade III certificates have been achieved.
