Director Jim Fritz Retires from Novato Sanitary District Board of Directors Following Over a Decade of Service.

Following over a decade of service as a director, Jim Fritz announced his retirement from the Novato Sanitary District Board saying the meeting of March 30th would be his last.

The Board of Directors acknowledged Jim's outstanding service to the District and the value that his considerable experience in water and wastewater engineering has provided to the District. Director Mike Di Giorgio spoke for the group when he said, "I will miss his knowledge of hydraulics and engineering which have been an enormous help to me and the Board."

More recently, Jim worked closely with staff on the upgrade of the District's new state-of-the-art treatment plant throughout the planning, design, and construction.

One of his legacies is that he provided an extensive collection of photos documenting the construction of the new treatment plant and other facilities.

Looking ahead, he hopes that his "board seat will be filled by a candidate that will help carry on the exemplary record of the District." He added that, "the staff rates high in public esteem, with good reason, and I am proud of my association with this fine organization."

Many people in Novato will also remember Jim for his many years of service to North Marin Water District (NMWD). He served NMWD as senior engineer or chief engineer from 1964 to 1988, and also served on the NMWD Board of Directors from 1990-94.

Jim has also been actively serving the community for over 40 years through membership in both the Novato and Novato Sunrise Rotary Clubs. Jim plans to continue his commitment to community service and to take time for more travel.
